FIRST QUARTER... (January, February, March)

Work progresses to reinvent the Pleasant Hill Road / Interstate 85 crossing

With a year-long interchange modification report (IMR) study coming to an end, the Gwinnett Place CID continues the hard work of pursuing a new Pleasant Hill Road bridge.

The CID underwrote the IMR effort as a key milestone in the lengthy reconstruction process. The federal government requires such a study to justify reworking the interchange.

The CID's Board of Directors named reconstructing the Pleasant Hill Road bridge as the District's top priority. The goal is to create a new single-point urban interchange, which would greatly increase capacity and allow for continuous traffic flows.

CID leaders are now working at the county level to include the bridge project for sales tax funding. Local dollars will help fund the preliminary engineering costs and other tasks related to the construction.



FIRST QUARTER HIGHLIGHTS...

PLAZA AT BRECKINRIDGE PROJECT LAUNCHES

CID representatives joined community and business leaders to mark the start of the new Plaza at Breckinridge development. The Plaza at Breckinridge was designed for approximately 24,748 square feet of Class-A retail condominium units, including an end unit with a drive-thru.

BUSINESS HQ LOCATES IN CID

The CID became home to a new company headquarters when Atlanta-based Kaufman Realty Group signed Xicom Wireless to lease 37,000 square feet at Gwinnett Center – 3505 Koger Boulevard at Pleasant Hill Road. Xicom is a leading provider of comprehensive metro-grade wireless services.

CID SHOWS STRONG SUPPORT FOR TADS LEGISLATION

The CID's Board of Directors approved a resolution in support of statewide legislation ensuring the full viability of tax allocation districts (TADs) for future redevelopment. The CID also engaged Massey and Bowers LLC to provide governmental consulting and advocacy in the General Assembly relative to TADs.

CID leads in unique redevelopment initiative to benefit Gwinnett Place

The Gwinnett Place CID took a leading role in educating the public regarding tax allocation districts (TADs). TADs allow anticipated future property value increases to leverage bonds and other funding options to pay for current infrastructure upgrades, accommodating redevelopment projects that might not otherwise occur.

Since the positive vote, the CID has created a redeveloped plan encompassing targeted zones inside greater Gwinnett Place. County Commissioners are now considering approval for the Gwinnett Place TAD.

CID leaders and stakeholders agree that a TAD will work well for the area as properties are in need of infrastructure upgrades to spur revitalization.

At the same time, the CID is meeting with developers, brokers, Chambers of Commerce, Partnership Gwinnett staff and others to bring attention to area real estate opportunities. The CID has also revamped its Web site to include listings of the District's available commercial properties.



SECOND QUARTER HIGHLIGHTS...

NEW LEADERSHIP ROLES FOR CID BOARD

Joe Piccolo, area/general manager for Gwinnett Place Mall and the Mall of Georgia, was elected by property owners of the CID to join its Board of Directors. Piccolo has been with Simon Property Group for more than 12 years.

At the same time, Marcy Adams, manager of the Atlanta Marriott Gwinnett Place, was selected to serve as the Board's Vice Chairman. Adams became the only female officer serving in a Gwinnett County CID.

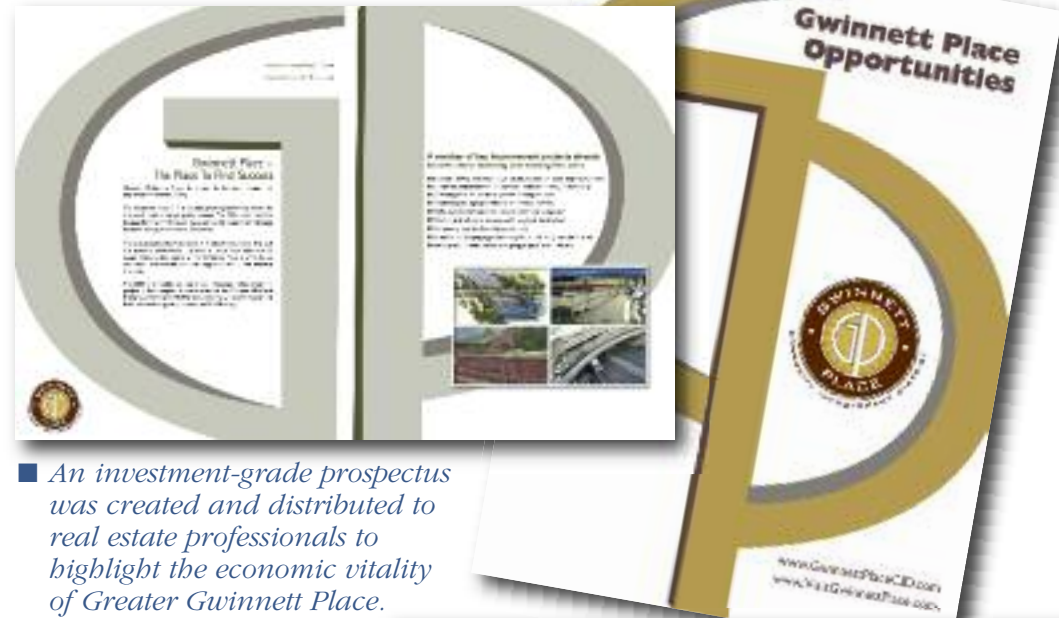
CID ADOPTS PLAN TO IMPROVE TRAFFIC

CID leaders moved to install illuminated street signs and other directional methods to such roadways as Steve Reynolds Boulevard, Shackelford Road, Venture Drive, Satellite Boulevard, Pleasant Hill Road and Venture Parkway.

NEW NON-PROFIT STATUS ESTABLISHED

The newly created, non-profit Gwinnett Place Community Improvement Foundation, Inc. will support the efforts of the CID's Board of Directors. The non-profit organization will better enable the CID to pursue available federal, state, local and private improvement grants.

THIRD QUARTER... (July, August, September)



■ An investment-grade prospectus was created and distributed to real estate professionals to highlight the economic vitality of Greater Gwinnett Place.



■ The new directional signs funded by the CID and Gwinnett County started appearing along prominent driving areas.



■ The CID took the lead to facilitate meetings between Simon Property Group and Gwinnett Tech's leadership to bring Gwinnett Technical College's International Center to Gwinnett Place Mall.

Plans and projects dramatically improving area travel



The CID contracted Wolverton & Associates to perform a traffic signal timing and optimization program throughout greater Gwinnett Place. Wolverton worked in conjunction with the Gwinnett Department of Transportation to test and correct timing issues at 45 of the area's busiest intersections.

During peak travel times, drivers will save about 98,000 hours and nearly 59,000 gallons of gasoline annually because of the CID's efforts. Lessened trip times and lowered fuel usage for area travel will generate savings of more than \$1.3 million per year.

Traffic congestion relief is a primary concern for the CID's Board of Directors, and many short-term efforts are aimed at addressing this issue.

The CID is also planning other long-term improvements to ease congestion. One such measure is the realignment of the Venture Drive-Pleasant Hill Road-Gwinnett Place Drive intersection.

The concept plan, which is funded by the CID and Gwinnett County, calls for widening Venture Drive from Pleasant Hill Road to Steve Reynolds Boulevard, allowing two through lanes in each direction and two-way left turn movement. The new design will improve area mobility by adding more options and better traffic flow.

THIRD QUARTER HIGHLIGHTS...

CID HIGHLIGHTED AREA DURING CONFERENCE

Greater Gwinnett Place received special attention when the CID provided investment-grade information at the southeast conference of the International Council of Shopping Centers (ICSC), which includes more than 75,000 members in more than 80 countries.

CRIME DROPS 32% INSIDE CID

The CID area experienced a 32% decrease in crime incidents through Fall 2008 from the same period in 2007. The most noticeable areas of improvement included:

- 47% reduction in armed robbery
- 22% decrease in motor vehicle theft
- 14% decrease in automobile break-ins

Data for the remainder of 2008 showed a continued decrease in such crimes as commercial burglary and auto break-ins.

LIGHT RAIL STUDY

The Gwinnett Place CID joined the Gwinnett Village CID to launch a light rail feasibility study. The CIDs committed funds to evaluate light rail connecting Doraville, Norcross, Gwinnett Village, Indian Trail, Gwinnett Place and the Arena at Gwinnett Center.

CID DAILY ADDRESSING DISTRICT UPKEEP

In 2008, the CID collected 2,128 bags of trash and removed more than 2,051 illegally placed signs. The CID maintains daily community patrols to quickly address any issues related to the area's appearance.

FOURTH QUARTER... (October, November, December)

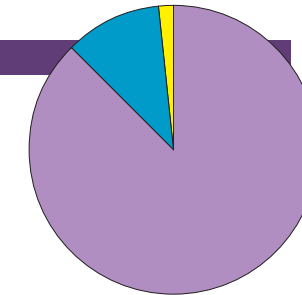

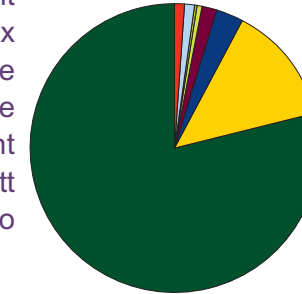

The Gwinnett Place Community Improvement District (CID) receives funding through special tax assessments on commercial property within the CID area to be used for purposes outlined by the Gwinnett County Community Improvement Districts Act. Taxes are collected by the Gwinnett County Tax Commissioner and are disbursed to the CID less a one-percent processing fee.

FOURTH QUARTER HIGHLIGHTS...

NEW CONSUMER-CENTERED SITE OPENS

The CID's Board of Directors initiated the new site, VisitGwinnettPlace.com, as a resource for District-based businesses. The site includes an interactive map and detailed listings specific to District businesses. CID representatives personally visited business owners and managers to discuss how they can access their complimentary listing and update it to include coupons, photos and special offers.

BILLBOARD SIGN PULLS IN DRIVERS

At the start of the holiday shopping season, the CID established a special billboard along southbound I-85. The prominent placement and colorful design helped point commuters to the newly redesigned Pleasant Hill Road exit.

CID FOCUSES ON FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE
