Chairman Williams called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. by welcoming all in attendance.

Ms. Adams motioned to approve the proposed meeting agenda; seconded by Mr. Wiener and unanimously approved.

Mr. Fanning motioned to approve the January 13, 2010 Board Mccting Minutes; seconded by Mr. Wisdom and unanimously approved.

Action/Consent Items

2010 Board Election Caucus

Mr. Rainey reviewed the 2010 Board of Directors election schedule. Mr. Wisdom motioned to call the election caucus for Post 2 and 5 and the election of board officers for April 14, 2010; seconded by Mr. Wiener and unanimously approved.

Security Review Committee Report and Recommendations

As Mr. Piccolo was unable to attend the board meeting, the issue will be deferred until the March board meeting. Mr. Allen directed the board members to the Gwinnett Place Community Improvement District RMS Incidents (Years 2007 to 2009) that was provided by the Gwinnett County Crime Analysis Unit. For the CID, there has been an overall 25% decrease in crime incidents from 2007 to 2009.

Pleasant Hill Road Bridge Project Update

Mr. Frey, URS Corporation, provided an update of the analysis from the VISSIM models that was presented to GDOT and Gwinnett DOT staff for review and determination of next steps for the bridge project. Mr. Frey noted that the average travel delay forecasted with the Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI) design shows a 32% improvement for the AM peak time and a 7% improvement for the PM peak travel time. There would be no impact to Interstate operations. Mr. Frey reviewed the proposed layout and other measures of effectiveness results with the board.

Mr. Fanning motioned to approve the Treasurer's Report and ratify the January expenses; seconded by Mr. Coffey and unanimously approved. Mr. Allen noted that as of January 31, the CID had \$1.6 million in cash. Assuming the budgeted tax revenues of \$1.1 million for 2010 are received with 2010 being the final tax revenue-producing year of the current CID lifecycle, the estimated available funding at the board's discretion through the end of October 2011 is approximately \$1.2 million, not including the funding for the Satellite Boulevard, Phase 1 and the Pleasant Hill Road, Phase 2 streetscaping projects.

Chairman's' Remarks

Mr. Williams noted the thank you note received from Mrs. Rosselle regarding the retirement luncheon for Dave Rosselle in January.

Board Member Remarks

Mr. McGahee noted that the Duluth TAD boundaries had been amended per Gwinnett County's request. He invited board members and audience participants to the Red Clay Theater Valentine's Day event on Saturday evening.

Public Relations

Mr. Corbin advised that work is presently underway on preparing the CID's 2009 Annual Report and should be completed this week. He noted the positive and high profile exposure for the Gwinnett Place CID in last week's Atlanta Business Chronicle.

Executive Session

Mr. Wiener motioned to enter into executive session to discuss an employment issue; seconded by Mr. Fanning and unanimously approved. At the conclusion of the discussion, Mr. Fanning motioned to end the executive session and return to the public business meeting; seconded by Mr. Wiener and unanimously approved.

Mr. Allen recommended the hiring of David McKinney to fill the Director of Operations position for an annual salary of \$50,000.00; \$250.00/month supplement for mileage and cell phone expenses, and \$100.00/month for Mr. McKinney to supplement medical health insurance obtained by him. Mr. Wiener motioned to approve the employment of Mr. McKinney effective March 1, 2010 at the recommended levels; seconded by Mr. Fanning and unanimously approved.

The meeting adjourned at 10:05 a.m. The next scheduled meeting is March 10, 2010 at the same location.
