Four higher-learning institutions now in Gwinnett Place area

The number of higher and continuing education alternatives continues to grow in the county's central business district, adding to greater Gwinnett Place's uniqueness within Gwinnett County. The Gwinnett Place CID this week welcomed the arrival of Shorter University, which opened a new adult and professional services campus at 3805 Crestwood Parkway.
