

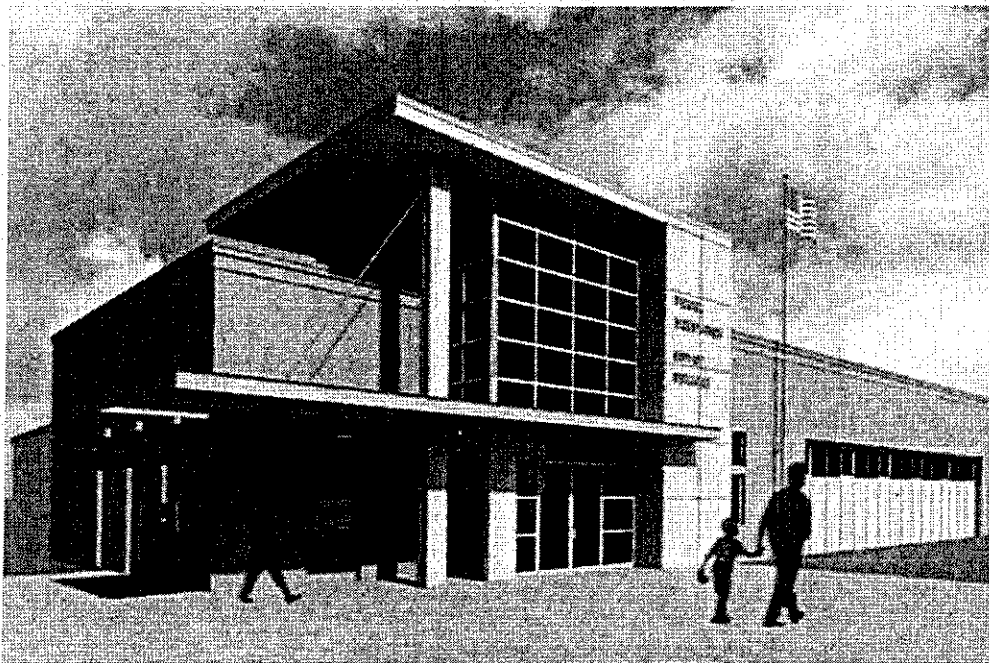

SUB-STATION: Suwanee is to get a new police sub-station, to open on the east side of Interstate 85 at 2966 Lawrenceville-Suwanee Road in the Gateway area. The 7,100 square foot station will cost approximately \$1.99 million, funded through SPLOST funds. Work will start on the facility near the first of the year. Hogan Construction Group of Norcross will be the contractor to a design by Tunnell-Spangler-Walsh & Associates of Atlanta. Completion is anticipated within eight months.
