#DULUTH – A two-day community workshop that aims to help residents work together to develop a unified vision for the intersection of some major roadways in Gwinnett County is scheduled for October.

#Held from 5 to 8 p.m. Oct. 4 and 6 at Ferguson Elementary in Duluth, all community members are invited to participate in the interactive workshop.

#The Gwinnett Place Community Improvement District has announced the upcoming workshop for the Gwinnett Livable Centers Initiative 10-year update.

#Joe Allen, executive director of Gwinnett Place CID, said the workshop is a chance for community members to "work together with the area leaders to develop a unified vision for the study area, identifying key catalyst sites and projects for development and redevelopment.

#"The resulting plan will drive job creation and economic development in the Gwinnett Place area over the next decade," Allen said.

#The 12-square mile Gwinnett LCI study area involves the intersection of major roadways in Gwinnett County including I-85, Ga. 316, Pleasant Hill Road, Ga. 120 and Satellite Boulevard.

#Professional planners, designers and market analysts will work with community workshop attendees to refine the needs of the study area through activities and educational sessions.

#Ferguson Elementary is located at 1755 Centerview Drive in Duluth.
