Gwinnett Place Mall Welcomes New Store Openings

DULUTH (March 26, 2009) – Gwinnett Place Mall brings new stores to the community this spring with the opening of It Is Soccer, Churro Factory, African Hair Braiding and a new showcase from Subaru of Gwinnett.

Subaru of Gwinnett is currently set up on the lower level next to Sears with a mini showroom displaying their latest new vehicles to shoppers.

It Is Soccer, a specialty store for sports lovers with soccer-related apparel and merchandise, will open April 1 on the lower level near Center Court.

Churro Factory will also open April 1 in the Food Court, offering tasty churros and coffee.

African Hair Braiding is now open on the upper level near JCPenney, offering the latest hairstyles for chic shoppers.

These new additions follow recent announcements for M International Market Place, scheduled to open at Gwinnett Place Mall in Fall 2009, and The International Education Center, a unit of Gwinnett Technical College, which opened at the mall in October 2008.

M International Market Place will represent the first upscale, multi-cultural department store of its kind in the United States. The store will open in the former Macy's location and offer an ambience specifically fashioned after Korean and Japanese luxury shopping plazas.

The International Education Center, a unit of Gwinnett Technical College, hosts a number of the college's continuing education classes, including language offerings and workforce training courses that support area businesses and meet the needs of our multilingual population. The center occupies an extensive space on the upper and lower level Belk wing.

Serving northeast metro Atlanta since 1984, Gwinnett Place Mall is anchored by four department stores including JCPenney, Belk, Macy's and Sears. Shoppers also have 200 specialty shops ranging from Abercrombie & Fitch, American Eagle Outfitters and Justice from which to choose. Gwinnett Place Mall hosts regular community events including Simon Kidgits Club and Moms & Tots. The mall also supports local school activities and Gwinnett County non-profit organizations.
