

Crime drops around Gwinnett Place Mall

New statistical data released by the Gwinnett County Police Department shows double-digit decreases in crime near Gwinnett Place Mall in Duluth.

Between 2007 and 2010, reports of crime overall have decreased 33 percent, according to the Gwinnett Place Community Improvement District. Robbery is down 42 percent; motor vehicle theft, 35 percent; theft, 33 percent; burglary, 24 percent; and fraud, 19 percent.

The number of traffic accidents in the area also also dropped 41% from 2007 to 2010.

The CID credits cooperation between the business community and the Gwinnett Police central precinct for the positive results.
