- The Rajbhog Café of Duluth has opened in the Market Place shopping center to offer "A Taste of the East."
- The new Nam San Gol Korean Restaurant recently opened in the Prado Shopping Center adjacent to the Great Wall Supermarket.
- Gwinnett Place Mall recently announced that it is adding to its retail offerings with four new stores -- 20 Below, Happy Land, Shoe Show and Stay Fly.
- And drivers traveling Satellite Boulevard can see the progress made in the total renovation and expansion of Gwinnett Place Ford.

The latest Gwinnett Place CID business report is "based on our observations while we are in the district," according to Executive Director Joe Allen. "We meet with new businesses as they move into the area to get their contact information, share information about CID projects and also put their businesses on our Visit Gwinnett Place website.
