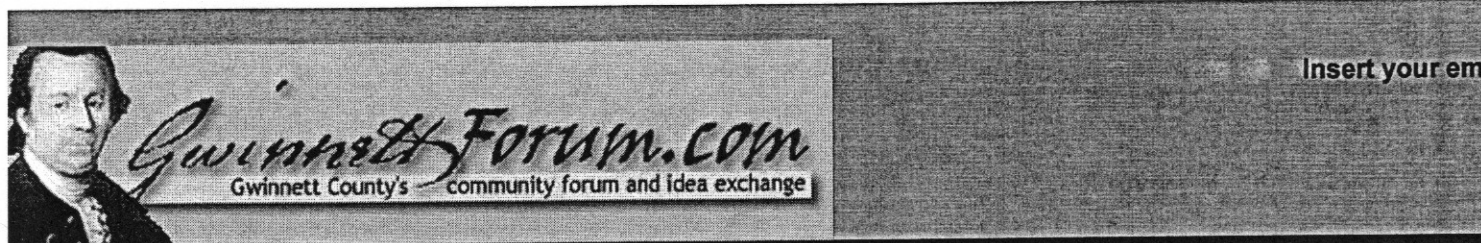

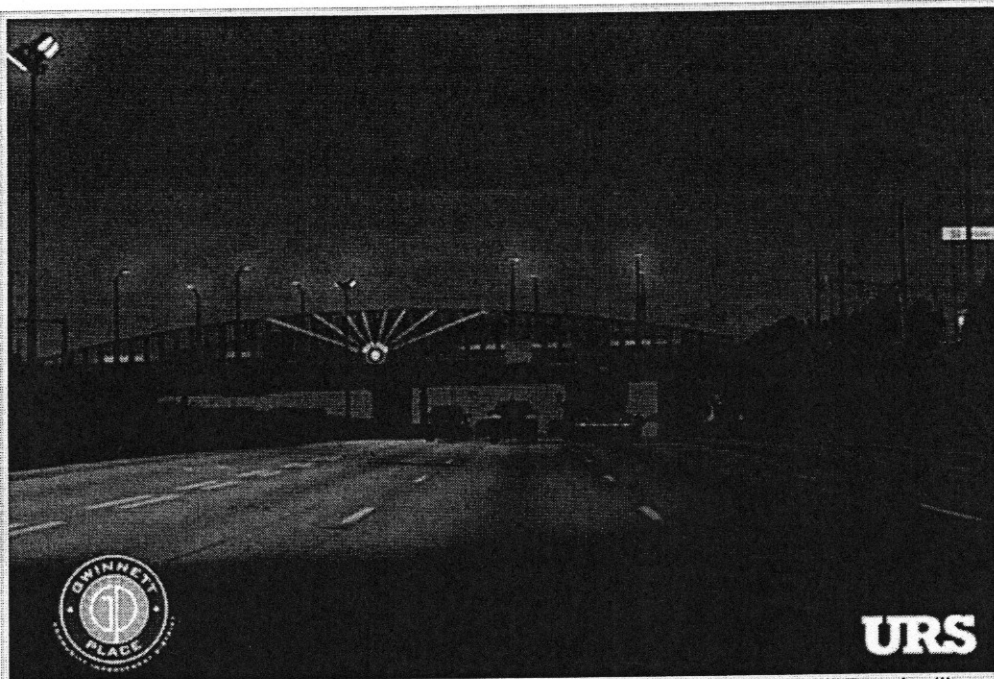

DIVERGING DIAMOND: Here's an artist's concept of what the Interstate 85 bridge at Pleasant Hill Road will look like once the diverging diamond concept is installed. CID Chairman Leo Wiener said special nighttime lighting, colors and landscaping will increase pedestrian and driver access while branding the bridge as the gateway entrance to greater Gwinnett Place. The project is anticipated to be completed in early 2012.



NEW APPROACH: Motorists traveling on Interstate 85 at Pleasant Hill Road will see special lighting treating the intersection once the Diverging Diamond concept is installed at this bridge.
