

Gwinnett CID unveils new look for Pleasant Hill Road bridge

LAWRENCEVILLE - The Gwinnett Place Community Improvement District has officially unveiled images showing what drivers will see as they approach the reconstructed Pleasant Hill Road bridge.

The renderings feature a "dynamic and aesthetically pleasing treatment" to the fence work that will line the bridge as a new interchange is installed beginning early next year.



A 16-member project steering committee developed the bridge's new appearance. Over several months of meetings, diverse opinions were gathered from international communities, area business owners, residents, county government staff, CID board members, planning consultants, Chamber of Commerce representatives and City of Duluth officials.
