





>>> we have an update on breaking news in cobb county. i-75 is now back open. this is just south of the 575 split. you're looking now at the northbound lanes. you see the tanker truck there. that's full of propane andit was on its side for hours today. crews shut down i-75 in both directions. it is now upright and they will be clearing the scene. several lanes of northbound 75 are still shut down, and traffic is backed up all the way to 285, ross cavitt is on the scene and we'll check in with him in about 15 minutes. >> major changes coming to two of i-85's overpasses. carl willis shows us how traffic will switch sides in what's called a diverging diamond. >> reporter: the idea is to push drivers over into the wrong lane to make an easier left to i-75. that way they'll get drivers on i-85 quicker and for a lot cheaper. this is what the changes coming to the interchanges will look like in action. it's called a diverging diamond interchange. we met on pleasant hill road to learn about the unorthodox approach. >> it's a morng scenario. and you'll see the cars stopping and crossing to the opposite side of the roadway. some will make a continuous left to i-85. >> customers are less likely to return to businesses because of the snarled traffic. the changes could improve delays by 25% or more. and it could encourage them to visit more often. >> we want everyone to come by and come see us and make it convenient for everyone. >> reporter: thebridge will need to be replaced eventually for a cost of \$58.5 million. but is project will delay it by 10 years and at a cost of four to \$5 million. >> we're able to use the existing bridge and get a decade or more out of it. >> reporter: developers hope to have an official bid out by spring if project finished by 2013. >> people can say wow, something different is going on here. >> reporter: not only wilthe project cost millions less to complete. but it will be a lot faster with 10 to 12 months to wrap up construction. carl willis, channel 2 action news. >>> the georgia supreme court has upheld the convictions of a coweta couple in the death of the woman's daughter. makayla mac was 2 years old
