



Gwinnett leaders and representatives of law enforcement agencies participated in a ribboncutting ceremony Friday (Aug 16) for a new Georgia State Patrol Post in the Duluth area.



The new Georgia State Patrol Post 51 is located at 1645 Pleasant Hill Road.

Thirty-seven state troopers will be stationed at the post, formed as the result of a partnership between the Georgia Department of Transportation and Georgia State Patrol.

Sqt. James Warren will serve as Post 51 commander.

Speakers at the ceremony included Gwinnett CommissionChairman Charlotte Nash, Gwinnett County Administrator Glenn Stephens, Georgia Department of Public Safety Commissioner Col. Mark McDonough, Georgia DOT Chief Engineer Russell McMurry, and Gwinnett Place CID Executive Director Joe Allen.
