

# ARC Grant To Fund Gwinnett CID Overlay

The Atlanta Regional Commission (ARC) has agreed to supply grant funds to the Gwinnett Place CID to complete a special study.

The ARC staff will match CID funds to produce an Overlay District plan for Gwinnett Place. The goal of the Overlay District is to provide flexible development guidelines and incentives while at the same time improving area transportation systems.


"Creating an Overlay District is a key recommendation from our recently submitted Comprehensive Redevelopment Plan. We expect an Overlay District to guide our future streetscapes and provide an overall unified plan governing the visible side of our revitalization efforts," said CID Chairman Mark Williams.

During the most recent round of Liveable Centers Initiative supplemental funding announcements, the Gwinnett Place CID was the only Community Improvement District to receive support. The CID is pre-qualified for a number of other ARC grant programs and is seeking an additional \$2.8 million in state/federal funds through the Transportation Enhancement Program.

The CID is seeking additional state/federal funds to complete streetscape, safety and transportation upgrades along Pleasant Hill Road and Satellite Boulevard.
